MORE FLIGHTS AS TIGER ANNOUNCES NEW ADELAIDE ROUTES

Adelaide Airport Ltd Managing Director Phil Baker today welcomed Tiger Airways' announcement that it would fly to Hobart, Gold Coast, Perth and Alice Springs from March 1, 2009, in addition to its existing Melbourne services.

"SA travellers will have more flights to choose from to major Australian destinations with Tiger's announcement of its initial four routes out of its new Adelaide base," Mr Baker said.

"Adelaide Airport's business continues to grow strongly. Attracting news services to major domestic destinations is clearly good news for travellers to and from South Australia, as well as our tourism and convention industries.

"It also creates further aviation-related jobs in Adelaide which in turn creates more business for our airport tenants including our T1 retail businesses. There are already more than 6000 people working at the Adelaide Airport site, making it the largest single employment precinct in the State."

Tiger will fly daily to Perth and the Gold Coast, four times a week to Hobart and three times a week to Alice Springs. It initially will base two aircraft at Adelaide Airport from early next year, with additional aircraft to be based here over the next 8 years.
